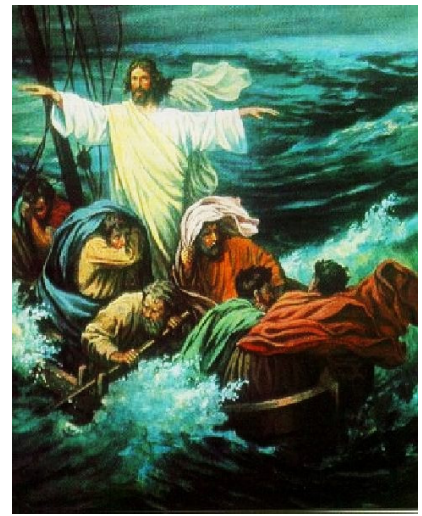

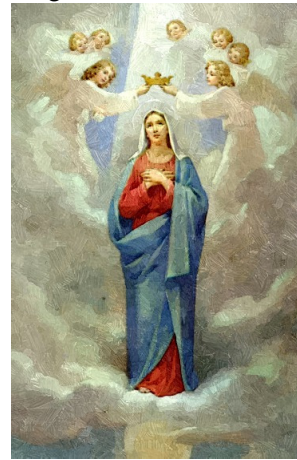

## The Feast of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary,

August 15th. This feast has a double object: (1) the happy departure of Mary from this life; (2) the assumption of her body into heaven. It is the principal feast of the Blessed Virgin. The teaching is aptly summarized in the *Catechism of the Catholic Church*, no. 974: The Most Blessed Virgin Mary, when the course of her earthly life was completed, was taken up "assumed" body and soul into the glory of heaven,



where she already shares in the glory of her Son's Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of His Body. The doctrine of Mary's Assumption is firmly rooted in sacred Scripture and Tradition, and this constant teaching was infallibly defined as a dogma of the Catholic faith by Pope Pius XII in 1950.

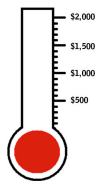
