Sacramental Preparation First Reconciliation & Holy Communion & Confirmation

The parishes in the Diocese of Peterborough are mandated to run a Sacramental Preparation Program. This is designed to assist the home, school and parish in nurturing the faith of the children who will be preparing to receive the sacraments. The Catholic schools provide Religious and Family Life Education for the children and the parishes provide the Sacramental Preparation.

If you have a child, in the Catholic Schools or in the public school, grade 2 or higher who needs to prepare for the **Sacraments of First Reconciliation and Eucharist**, *Parent Information Day* will be held in the Church on **Saturday, September 16, 2017 at 9:30 am OR Tuesday, September 19, 2017 at 6:00 pm.** You need to only attend one.

Confirmation: Youth grades 7 and higher will also received preparation through the school and through the Church. *Parent Information Day* will be held in the Church on **Monday, September 18, 2017 at 6:00 pm.**

Baptism of School age children: If you have a school age child who is in need of Baptism, please contact the office for preparation.

Adult formation (RCIA) If you are an adult interested in receiving the sacraments of Baptism and/or Eucharist & Confirmation, please contact the parish office.
